

## Context Clues Practice Answers

**Correction Note:** Many times a combination of context clue categories may help readers find the meaning of unknown words. Students may wish to share why they identified a different **SALE** context clues category.

### SALE Context Clues

**Synonym**—Sometimes an unknown word is defined by the use of a word that is similar in meaning.

**Antonym**—Sometimes an unknown word is defined by the use of word that is different or opposite in meaning.

**Logic**—Sometimes an unknown word is explained by the use of other words.

**Example**—Sometimes an unknown word is defined by example words or is used as part of list of similar examples.

### Hiking in the Mountains

There is nothing quite like the smell of pine trees, the sound of a stream trickling down from the edge of a crystal clear lake, or the **werpdug** sight Example of a black bear scratching on a granite boulder directly in front of the **latrick** trail Logic you walk. To enjoy **triting** hiking Synonym, you must need some equipment. Good **suties** boots Logic will support your ankles so you won't slip. Wearing polyester clothes and socks will help keep them from sticking to the skin when your body starts **moting** sweating Logic. Bringing a compass and a **ying** map Example of the area will help you stay on the trail and not get **jith** lost Antonym. The most important thing to pack is water. Water keeps hikers hydrated, not **futed** thirsty Antonym, and prevents heat exhaustion. Plus, mountain water is not always safe to drink.
