Spelling Rule:
 Double the consonant when adding on a suffix if the word ends in a vowel (e).
 Example: cat - cats

Syllable Rule:
 Divide syllables between doubled consonants.
 Example: for - for - ing
 Double split the doubled consonants if the doubled consonant is part of a base word.
 Example: full - fill - ment
